SUBJECT: Landing Kentucky Wing Aircraft in Adjacent States

In accordance with blanket permission granted by Col Charles Carr, Commander, Great Lakes Region and Col James Rushing, Commander, Southeast Region, Kentucky Wing Aircraft are authorized to land at any airport in the states of Ohio, Indiana, and Tennessee that is within 50 nautical miles of the Kentucky State Line, provided that the requirements of CAPR 60-1 Paragraph 2-2b are met.

If the airport is farther than 50 nautical miles from the Kentucky State Line, the requirements of CAPR 60-1 Paragraph 2.2c still apply.

This permission would continue until revoked or a change of above stated regulation in CAPF 60-1 making this authorization no longer necessary.
