SUBJECT: Release of Pilots Shown as Unqualified in WMIRS

The WMIRS Electronic Flight Release System will give FRO's numerous warnings if they attempt to release a flight with an unqualified Pilot-In Command. However, it will still allow the FRO to release the flight by noting the reasons for the release as exceptions.

Despite this capability, Kentucky Wing FRO's shall not release a pilot shown as unqualified in WMIRS, either electronically or using a paper Form 99, even if the FRO is certain that the pilot is qualified.

Pilots shall contact the Wing Director of Operations or the Wing Stan/Eval Officer or Assistant Stan/Eval Officer if he/she believes his/her qualifications as shown in WMIRS are incorrect. Copies of documentation showing the pilot is qualified must be made available to the person contacted before corrections will be made in Operations/Qualifications. Every attempt will be made to correct the qualifications, but last-minute corrections are not guaranteed.

Pilots will receive notification during the sortie entry process if they are not qualified for the sortie they are entering. Pilots should review their qualifications occasionally to make sure they are correct.
